What is the PIT Count?

The Annual Homeless Point-in-Time Count is a federally mandated count of the people experiencing homelessness in Medina County on a single night. The Medina Metropolitan Housing Authority (MMHA) is the Coordinated Entry access point for all homeless persons in Medina County.

When:

The count is the night of **January 28, 2025 starting at 8:00 p.m.** Teams of two or more will travel to various locations in Medina County where homeless people are known to be.
